David Abercrombie's Birth Found

David Abercrombie, who played one game for the Troy Haymakers in 1871, was born in Falkirk, Scotland in 1840. Peter Morris has a sister living in Scotland and she found Abercrombie's birth record. He was born May 6, 1840. For this, the Morris family wins the October Find of the Month award. We have very few birthdates for ballplayers recorded in 1840 or before and this is especially noteworthy since the birth occurred in a foreign country.

Abercrombie lived to be 76 and for nearly four years (according to what we know) was the oldest living ex-major leaguer. He held this distinction from Alfred Barker's death in 1912 until he died in 1916, relinquishing the honor to Alfred Reach. Great work! Now if Pete only had a sister in Cuba.

Confusion

We have several questions regarding players posed by Bob Richardson, Bob Tholkes, And Pete Palmer. Can anyone shed any more light on these?

John J. (Rooney) Sweeney - According to the <u>Boston Herald</u> Sweeney wanted the NY club to sign him in 1891. We have Sweeney dying in 1889 in New York City.

Tom Dolan - Again according to the <u>Boston</u> Herald, Dolan, the old St. Louis catcher, was electrocuted by stepping on a live wire in late April or early May 1894. We have Dolan dying in 1913.

Joe Dowie - Was fatally shot bt Negroes in New Orleans September 3 or 4, 1893.

Joseph Burke - The captain of the Muncie team died August 27, 1893 of injuries suffered in a game. Is this missing 1890 player Joseph A. Burke?

John McDonald - We have a questionnaire on this 1907 player which says that he was born 12/11/1881 in Nesquehoning, Pennsylvania and died 11/16/1972 in Allentown, Pennsylvania. Do we have the right player?

Doug Linton - We have his birth as 2/9/1965 and most sources have 9/2/1965.

Ben McDonald - We have his birth as 11/14/1967 and most sources have 11/24/1967.

A Babe In The Woods

I received a letter from a gentleman in California regarding 1907 St. Louis player John Burnett. It appears quite likely that we have the wrong man. An excerpt from his letter follows:

"The birthdate for Jack Burnett of 12/02/1889 which is given is almost certainly in error. Jack was a teammate of Walter Johnson's on the powerful Olinda Oil Wells semipro team. In fact, he was already the team captain at the time Walter joined the Oil Wells in January 1905. In a 1913 article describing his discovery of Walter Johnson, another Olinda teammate, Joe Burke, describes how Burke and Burnett gave Johnson an impromptu tryout in the field next to the Olinda general store. This tryout took place, as best we can determine, sometime in 1904. Burke describes Burnett as 'Olinda's best hitter'; contemporary newspaper accounts refer to him as the captain of the team. Most of the Olinda players at the time were in their twenties. It is unlikely they would have been captained by a 15-year-old boy.

Jack Burnett was signed to a pro contract with Seattle (PCL) early in 1906, then traded to Tacoma (NWL). While at Tacoma, he arranged for Walter Johnson to join the Tacoma team, but after pitching one game against Grays Harbor, which may or may not have been an exhibition game, Walter was released, then caught on with a semipro team in Weiser, Idaho. Catcher Cliff Blankenship signed him for Washington there the following summer. Burnett stayed at Tacoma and was sold to the St. Louis Cardinals in 1907. What happened to him after that one big league season we do not know."

This would appear to cast enough doubt on the accuracy of our John Burnett to make Burnett our October Mystery of the Month.
