# Joseph Simmons Found

Joseph Simmons made his major league debut in 1871 and 1871 players are not very easy to track down. But thanks to a great collaborative effort from Richard Malatzky, Peter Morris, Bob Richardson, and Debbi Dagavarian-Bonar, we were able to pin this guy down. What made this especially difficult is that by the time of his death, he had changed his name back to its original Joseph S. Chabriel.

Simmons was living in Rochester, New York in 1880 and Richard had found his census listing that showed his family, including sons George and Arthur. Richard found a later note that Simmons had moved to Syracuse and Joseph Simmons shows up in the Syracuse city directories of the late 1890s with George and Arthur.

Now things start to get interesting. Bob Richardson found a note in a 07/28/1901 Worcester, Massachusetts paper that Simmons had died the preceding week in Jersey City and that his real name was Chiribel. Richard then went to the Jersey City directories and found a Joseph Chabriel living with George and Arthur. Then Debbi Dagavarian-Bonar found Joseph Chabriel's death certificate showing that he died on July 24, 1901 at age 55, the right age for Joe Simmons. Debbi, Richard, Peter, and Bob all share the Find of the Month award.

# Maybe 1871 Guys Aren't Hard After All

Richard Malatzky and Peter Morris did a great job tracking down James Carleton of the 1871-72 Cleveland Forest Citys. They pieced together a long string of clues spanning around 30 years. The main clue to tie everything together was that Carleton was an electrician for the telephone company and made lots of money during the early days of the telephone.

Richard and Peter were literally able to trace his path from his 1848 birth in Clinton, Connecticut through Brooklyn where he lived as a young man through Cleveland where he played baseball on to Detroit where he married a Detroit girl and made most of his money and where he died in 1910. Outstanding job of research!

#### Sorry About That, Schultz

A man listed as John Schultz played one game with St. Louis in 1891. Notes in The Sporting News said that he was a chairmaker and later a mailman. Peter Morris and Richard Malatzky traced a man through the St. Louis directories that precisely fit that description.

Richard recently found an index to Catholic cemeteries in St. Louis. He found John H. Schulze listed there and his family matched the man they had been tracing. His obituary then confirmed the find by stating that he had been a former catcher with the St. Louis Browns. Interestingly enough, this obituary appeared in the sports section even though he only played one game in the majors and it was 50 years before his death. This index may key us in to finding several players in St. Louis.

## Charles Briggs

Another missing player that was tracked down recently was Charles Briggs, an 1884 player. He was born in Batavia, Illinois, but Peter Morris tracked him to Seattle, Washington. He died in Seattle, but his body was shipped back to Batavia.

#### The Other Charlie Jones

Much has been written about missing ballplayer Charles Wesley Jones, still one of our most mysterious missing players. However, our Mystery of the Month this month features Charles F. Jones, who played 25 games for Brooklyn in the American Association in 1884.

Quite a bit is known about his career. Prior to playing with Brooklyn, he played with Newark in 1884, then again in 1885, 1888, and 1889. He was with Worcester in 1889 and 1890 and then with Lebanon, Providence, and Troy in 1891.

The 1880 Brooklyn census shows William and Mary Jones, ages 54 and 55, respectively, with children William E., 28, Charles F., 21, Hiram M., 19, David, 15, and Mary, 11. The parents and oldest child were born in New Jersey, while the rest of the children were born in New York.

The 1900 Brooklyn census shows Charles F. Jones (05/1859) and Adair A. (04/1864) with children Rhida (05/1882), Charles F. (07/1885), and Lester (03/1889). They were living at 128 Jefferson in Brooklyn and he was a clerk at the National Biscuit Company, where he was undoubtedly rolling in dough. He was last listed in the New York City city directory in 1918. Although he has a common name, enough is known where we ought to be able to find him.
