Fred Hayner Found

Richard Topp was sitting at home reading his Sunday Chicago Sun-Times when he was stunned to read an article by a deputy editor at the paper named Don Hayner writing about his grandfather Fred Hayner. The article stated that Fred Hayner "once pitched to Cap Anson in a big league tryout." Rich was aware that that we had listed a John Heyner who pitched one game for Pittsburgh in 1890 against Chicago in Chicago. Rich called Joe Simenic who researched the game through Sporting Life and discovered that his name was always listed as Hayner and no first name was ever given. Undoubtedly, this was our missing player. Rich was able to obtain birth and death information from the grandson and Lake Forest College.

Even more interesting is that Fred Hayner also became a sportswriter and is credited with coming up with the name Cubs for the Chicago National League team. It's incredible that we never found him before. Hayner died in a fire in 1929. For finding Hayner Rich wins the September/October Find of the Month award.

Rookie List

Attached you will see the list of 208 1998 rookies. This gives us exactly 15,000 major league players since 1871. Here are some notes about the rookies.

There were several rookies who are related to other big leaguers. Brian Barkley is the son of Jeff Barkley, Kirk Bullinger is the brother of Jin Bullinger, Jose Cora is the brother of Joey Cora, Jeremy Giambi is the brother of Jason Giambi, Jerry Hairston, Jr. is the son of Jerry Hairston, Sr. and grandson of Sam Hairston, Orlando Hernandez is the brother of Livan Hernandez, Stephen Larkin is the brother of Barry Larkin,

Fred Rath, Jr. is the son of Fred Rath, Sr., Justin Speier is the son of Chris Speier, and Daryle Ward is the son of Gary Ward.

The youngest rookie was Aramis Ramirez who debuted at 19. The oldest was Masato Yoshii, who was 33. The shortest was Donnie Sadler who is 5-06 and the tallest were Scott Elarton, Ben Ford, Ryan Minor, and Blake Stein, who are all 6-07.

Every year I also pick my favorite name among the rookies. This year I noticed that we had players named after a rock singer (Rickey Nelson Cradle), a baseball player (Paul Dean Crow), and an architect (Christopher Wren Fussell). But my favorite has to be Bronswell Dante Patrick. It has such a melodic ring to it.

Ralph Horton

Sadly, I have to report that one of our committee members, Ralph Horton, died the other day. I had the pleasure of knowing Ralph pretty well. He was a very nice man and would always do whatever he could to help anyone out with their research. We will all miss him.

New Ballplayer

We had listed Frank Larkin as playing for both Richmond (AA) and Washington (UA) in 1884. Joe Simenic researched these players and discovered that on July 4, 1884, there were 3 Larkins appearing in games. Henry Larkin was playing for the Philadelphia Athletics. Frank Larkin was playing for Richmond in the Eastern League. An unknown Larkin was playing for Washington (UA).

By the way, Frank Larkin was quite an

interesting fellow. When Joe was researching the Larkins, he found this article from the February 27, 1884 Sporting Life:

"Frank Larkin, the well-known pitcher and second baseman, appears to be an incorrigible ruffian. Last spring he beat his wife and then shot an officer who attempted to arrest him. For this, he was sent to the penitentiary. A week ago his time expired and he was released, but all his relatives with the exception of his old father, refused to receive him. The old man, who lives in a garret at No. 92 North Fourth Street, Brooklyn, welcomed his wayward son, gave him some clothes, and let him sleep on a cot in the garret. On Monday, Larkin went home drunk, and dragging his father out of bed, threatened to shoot him. The old man escaped and ran to the Fifth District Station house. The next day Larkin was held on \$1,000 bail to answer a charge of felonious assault. The police say that Larkin is one of the most dangerous men in Brooklyn, and that if he is allowed to go at large he will certainly murder someone."

Please note that he was back in the majors later that year, proving that there isn't as much difference in modern day baseball as we think.

The Modern Player?

Ray Hayworth, a catcher who broke in with the 1926 Tigers, is now 94 years old. He is the last player alive who was a teammate of Ty Cobb's. I recently received a copy of the Ray Hayworth newsletter. I'm sure most of you didn't realize there was such a publication, but for \$2.00 you can obtain a catalog of items available from Ray's 50 years in baseball. Chet Hoff

With the death of Chet Hoff at the age of 107, I thought Lou Polli would become our oldest living ex-major leaguer. Polli is only 97. However, it recently came to light that Karl Swanson shaved 3 years off his age when he was playing. Swanson was actually born December 17, 1900 instead of 1903. Hoff became the oldest ex-player in 1990 with the death of Paul Otis and held the title for 7 years. Hoff could actually celebrate the 87th anniversary of his major

league debut and at the time of his death was more than 10 years older than any other former big leaguer. Those records might be tough to break.

Chatter Behind the Plate

Norm Richards, a scout for the Houston Astros, sent me the box score of a Midwest League game played in 1959 between Keokuk and Michigan City. The Keokuk catcher was future sportscaster Tim McCarver. The umpire was future sportscaster Brent Musberger. As you may know, McCarver and Musberger would later be teamed together on CBS baseball telecasts. I imagine the batters (which, by the way, included future big leaguers Jose Tartabull and Ricardo Joseph) got an earful that day.

The Baseball Starr Report

I must admit that I did not read one bit of the Starr report. However, Tom Hufford tells me that one former major leaguer was mentioned in it. That was Secret Service Agent Bill Bordley, who embarked on a second career after twirling for the 1980 Giants.

Home Run Duffee

Cliff Otto sent along an article indicating the Frank Baker was not the first ballplayer to be known by the nickname "Home Run." Charles "Home Run" Duffee clubbed 15 homers for St. Louis (AA) in 1889 and also finished in double figures with 10 (2 behind the league leader) with Columbus in 1891. Duffee died of tuberculosis at the age of 28 in 1894.

Selkoisms

Jamie Selko, master of the unusual, has the following ballplayers who were 1st or 2nd string basketball All-Americans: Frank Baumholtz, 2nd in 1941, Don Grate, 2nd in 1944-45, Dick Groat, 2nd in 1951, 1st in 1952, Johnny O'Brien, 2nd in 1952, 1st in 1953, and Cotton Nash, 2nd in 1962-63, 1st in 1964.

Dave Madison is the only major leaguer who can trace his ancestry directly back to a former President of the United States. I'll leave it to you to guess which one. Jamie would also like to know if Bronson Wayne Heflin was named after two famous actors.

More on Moore

Joe Simenic looked into our May/June Mystery of the Month, George Moore. Joe found that he was really Frank Moore and that he came from Uhrichsville, Ohio. Jim Troisi sent me an article from a Pittsburgh paper which confirmed the same information. He was nicknamed Peggy. He was a big guy, 6-04, 200. The only other information on him was that his hands were as big as an ordinary sized ham. Makes me wonder if his nickname was Peggy or Piggy.

We have four players who have no first name, the recently discovered Mr. Larkin as well as McRemer, Franklin, and Morris. The other missing Unions are Al Bradley, Martin Creegan, James Green, Michael Lehane, Frank McKee, James McLaughlin, John Mulligan, Maurice Pierce, Daniel Sheehan, Arthur Thompson, John Ward, John Wiley, David Drew, Edward Reeder, Edward McKenna, and William White. If anyone would like to do research on this team, there is no shortage of missing ballplayers to seek out.
