Edward Cassian Found

Edward Cassian, pitcher for Philadelphia and Washington in 1891, has been found by Bob Richardson and Rich Bozzone. Bob and Rich share the October Find of the Month award.

Bob found a note in the 1891 Boston papers that the Philadelphia pitcher Cassian had not played in a while because of the death of his mother. Coupled with a note Bob had indicating that Cassian was from Hartford, Bob checked the 1892 city directory which showed that Kate Cassian (widow of Michael) had died June 26, 1891. The 1900 Connecticut census showed an Edward Cashin living in Middletown, Connecticut. Bob and Rich both suspected that

this was our ballplayer.

Cassian appeared in the Middletown city directory in 1916 and 1917. So Rich made a trip to Middletown to check death records from 1918-22. Finding nothing even similar to his last name, Rich asked the clerk if they had burial records for people that did not die in Middletown but were buried in cemeteries there. She gave him another file and he found Edward Cassian buried September 12, 1918 in St. John's New Cemetery. Rich then obtained the death certificate of Edward Cassian, son of Michael and Catherine, who died September 10, 1918 in Meriden, Connecticut. He also found an obituary in a Middletown paper, which referred to him as a former Philadelphia pitcher. Outstanding research by Bob and Rich!

1997 Rookie List

As you can see, I have attached the 1997 rookie list. This year there were 180 rookies, 55

of which were foreign born. No new countries were represented this year. The foreign player tally includes 22 from the Dominican Republic, 12 from Venezuela, 5 from Puerto Rico, 4 from Mexico, 3 from Japan, 3 from Canada, 1 from Panama, 1 from Cuba, 1 from Colombia, 1 from Australia, 1 from Curacao, and 1 from Spain.

There were several players who were either sons or brothers of other major leaguers. Aaron Boone is the brother of Bret, son of Bob, and grandson of Ray. Rich Butler is the brother of Rob. Jose L. Cruz is the son of Jose. Ben Grieve is the son of Tom, Pete Rose, Jr. is the son of Pete, Sr., Jose Javier Valentin is the brother of Jose Antonio Valentin (their parents liked the name), and Jaret Wright is the son of Clyde.

There were 4 rookies named Cruz, but none named Smith. For only the 5th time since 1871, there were no rookies born in any of the boroughs of New York City. For the record, the other years were 1903, 1973, 1979, and 1989. The oldest rookie was Shawn Gilbert, who was 32; the youngest was Dennis Reyes, who was 20. The tallest was Sean Maloney at 6-07; the shortest were Giomar Guevara and Jason McDonald, both 5-08. The heaviest was Dennis Reyes at 246 and the lightest was Giomar Guevara at 150.

Finally, we've arrived at the moment you've all been waiting for when I pick my favorite name among the rookies. It was a close race, and just nosing out Jed Ramon Hansen is the winner, born on my birthday, Richmond Lockwood Sexson.

Setting The Wheelers in Motion

The 1920 Indians, who can probably generate more trivia questions than any other team, had two players whose first or middle name was Wheeler. They had Joseph Wheeler Sewell and Wheeler "Doc" Johnston. Interestingly, both of these men had brothers who played in the major leagues. Thanks to Scott Flatow for providing that piece of trivia.

Shouldn't They Call It Laryville?

Never let it be said that the town of Northport, Alabama isn't proud of its most famous baseball player. Both Frank Lary and his older brother Al were born in Northport and still live there. Frank lives on Baseball Drive and Al lives on Frank Lary Road. By the way, according to our records, the brothers are amazingly close in age. Al was born September 26, 1929 and Frank was born April 10, 1930, a difference of 6 months, 15 days. Does this seem a bit suspicious?

Miss America

Bill Simpson, who obviously keeps abreast of Miss America's vital information, writes that Miss America of 1998, Kate Shindle, is from the New Jersey environs of Philadelphia. Does anyone know if she is related to 1890s third baseman Billy Shindle?
