### An Introduction to CBP

CBP is a quarterly publication of the SABR Bibliography Committee. Its purpose is to list all the baseball related publications published during each quarter. Publications are grouped into the following eleven broad categories:

Although some publications may belong in more than one of these categories, they are listed only once in their most obvious (at least to the compiler) category. Entries are numbered and run consecutively through each issue. Each entry contains the following information (or as much as is known)

author (s). Title. Publisher. Address of publisher if a small press or self published. phone of small publisher. number of pages, whether it contains photographs, index, bibliography, notes, chronology, statistics, etc, price, paperback (P) or hardcover (H), ISBN or ISSN number. If a reprint, publisher and date of previous editions and occasionally comments on the publication.

For this issue, publications listed are those available by September 30, 1994. Entries are not normally repeated until the years end issue (the fifth issue usually out in February for the previous year). For other publications released in 1994 see previous issues of CBP.
