It's Election Time for the Rocky Mountain SABR Chapter

The nomination period for open RMSABR Board seats ended on September 7th. The election ballot will be sent to all chapter members on September 22nd.

This year, SABR members will vote for the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer (collectively known as the "RMSABR Officers") and three At -Large Director positions. All nominated and elected officers and directors shall be individual members of the Chapter continuously for one year prior to taking office and must be in "good standing" with SABR in accord-

ance with the SABR By-Laws under Article II.

The chapter will be voting for the following positions: President (2 yr. term); Vice President (2 yr. term); Secretary (2 yr. term); Treasurer (2 yr. term) and three At-Large Directors (4 yr. term)

RMSABR Members Encouraged to Visit the Chapter's Freshly Updated Website


