Carlis Wright Robinson is the daughter of John Wright, a pioneer Negro League pitcher who played for the Homestead Grays, the Newark Eagles, the Toledo Crawfords, and the New Orleans Zulus. He was also invited to a tryout in 1946 with the Brooklyn Dodgers along with Jackie Robinson. Sadly, her father passed away in 1990 at the age of 72. On October 23, 2022, Carlis participated in the unveiling of a historic marker at Kelly Field in Daytona Beach, Florida, where John Wright and Jackie Robinson integrated spring training with the Montreal Royals.
