

The Anthony A. Yoseloff Foundation, Inc. 2022 SABR Analytics Conference Scholarship Application

Below are instructions for the 2022 application process.

SABR will award scholarships to high school and college students who wish to attend the SABR Virtual Analytics Conference on March 18-20, 2022. This scholarship will pay for all registration fees and expenses associated with the conference.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Currently enrolled in high school, college, or graduate program.
- 2. Ages between 18-29.
- 3. Proof of attendance at SABR Analytics is required for reimbursement.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Application must be completed in full.
- 2. Your essay must be attached to your application.
- 3. Your submission must include a letter of recommendation from a current high school/college teacher, guidance counselor or a school administrator.
- 4. Some form of age verification (photocopy of driver's license, passport, etc.) must be attached to your application.

The Scholarship Committee for SABR will review all the applications and make the selections. *Note, only one essay will be accepted per applicant.* The scholarship winners will be notified by January 29, 2022.

An applicant may also apply for a scholarship to attend the SABR 50 Annual Convention in Baltimore. However, an applicant can only be awarded one scholarship, so, if applying for both scholarships, the applicant must indicate which scholarship is preferred.

Any previous winner of a Yoseloff scholarship is not eligible for a future scholarship. In addition, any participant in the Diamond Dollars Case Competition is not eligible for the Analytics scholarship.
