

Step-by-step instructions on how to use Paper of Record as a SABR member

1. Go to SABR.org/paperofrecord and log in using your SABR username and password.

Please note: You should never need to log in at the Paper of Record website; your SABR username and password will not work on their site. You can only access the Sporting News archives by logging in at the SABR website link here: sabr.org/paperofrecord.

IMPORTANT: You MUST log in using your **primary email address**. No other username will work except for a valid e-mail address.

BOSTON, Mass.—Though the Red Sox long since had clinched second place and could not go any higher, interest in the final week of their scheduled games was as keen as it had been in any week of the season. And as high as it had been all week, it reached its peak Sunday, September 22, the final day of the American League season. Teddy Williams was the reason!

**WILKES-BARRE PLACES
THREE ON 'ALL-STARS'**Embree, Conway Selected Along With
Barton, Who Is Unanimous Choice
in Eastern League Balloting

WILLIAMSPORT, Pa.—Headed by Larry Barton, the Jeep's most valuable player, Wilkes-Barre's pennant-winning Barons led the pack in the number of places on the Eastern League's annual all-star team, selected by the Eastern League Writers' Association. The Barons landed three among the elite—Shortstop Jack Conway and Pitcher Red Embree, in addition to First Sacker Barton.

Barton's popularity as an all-round performer was emphasized in the all-star balloting even more strongly than in the most valuable competition, which he won going away. The Baron basher, a key man in Wilkes-Barre's triumphant pennant charge, was a unanimous choice for the initial base post, polling a first-team vote (two points) from every one of the 18 scribes who balloted.

Embree, who won 21 games and was the runner-up to Barton as the most valuable, also was second to Barton in the all-star vote. Embree's mound running mate on the mythical team was Virgil (Hooks) ...
