

The Nanar and Anthony Yoseloff Foundation, Inc. SABR 52 Scholarship Application

Below are instructions for the 2024 application process.

There will be up to (4) scholarships awarded from SABR to current high school and college students that wish to attend SABR's 52nd annual convention on August 7-11, 2024, in Minneapolis, MN. This scholarship will pay for registration, transportation, and lodging (double occupancy) up to a total value of \$1,250.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Currently enrolled in high school, college, or graduate program.
- 2. Ages between 18-29.
- 3. Proof of attendance at SABR 52 is required for reimbursement.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Application must be completed in full.
- 2. Your essay must be attached to your application.
- 3. Your submission must include a letter of recommendation from a current high school/college teacher, guidance counselor or a school administrator.
- 4. Some form of age verification (photocopy of driver's license, passport, etc.) must be attached to your application.

The Scholarship Committee for SABR will review all applications and make selections. *Note, only one essay will be accepted per applicant.* Scholarship winners will be notified by June 7, 2024.

An applicant may also apply for a scholarship to attend a future SABR Analytics Conference. However, an applicant can only be awarded one scholarship, so, if applying for both scholarships, the applicant must indicate which scholarship is preferred.

Any previous winner of a Yoseloff Scholarship is not eligible for a future scholarship.
