If the information warrants - the Hall of Fame might some day consider putting a scout in the Hall of Fame. At this time - and for a long time in the future, in all probability - we're dedicated to making a corner in the Hall of Fame Museum as good as it can be.

Second - I'm sorry I turned off several of you because I have no e-mail and no computer. Sounds a little like the Padres' front office. For all concerned, it ain't gonna happen. I'll live by the pen, paper, fax, phone, and snail mail. You are basically dealing with a dinosaur.

WAYNE MCELREAVY

DICK CLARK

A welcome communication came from Dick Clark which reads "I have located several thousand players and shall continue to research it. I have a ton of press guides and should be able to team scouting rosters also." Dick lives in Ypsilanti, Michigan. Obviously, he's a key player in the past, present, and future of this committee.

THE MAJOR LEAGUES

A personal letter was sent to all 30 major league organizations - to either the scouting director or the general manager - seeking someone who might serve us as a contact with that club who could supply us with as much data as is available regarding that particular team. Two have replied.

Roland Hemond replied that he and Arizona Diamondback scouting director, Mike Rizzo, would be available. He referred us to Nick Kamzic, a 50-year scouting veteran, who will also help.

The Phillies have asked veteran public relations director Larry Shenck to be our contact with Philadelphia.

Twenty-eight others have not answered, but all will have a chance to catch up the Phillies and Diamondbacks with this mailing.

GREENWADE AWARD

Former chairman Kreuz gave an annual award to the person who identified the greatest number of "who signed whoms" during that calendar year. Your new chairman plans to continue that practice. Not sure what we'll give, but we'll find something. Jim - we need to know who won each year and how many credits each winner had. Were they professional signings or major league signings?? Remember - for every 20 who sign only one will become a major league regular.

We'll present the award again at the 2001 SABR convention and it will be based on credits earned between Nov. 15, 2000, and June 1, 2001. The award in 2002 will be based on data submitted between June 1, 2001, and Jan. 1, 2002. After that, we'll operate on a calendar year basis.

The award will go to the person who lists the most signings, regardless of the level. With such data base, the future will be easy.

UPCOMING PROJECTS

- 1 - Compile a list of scouts, club-by-club, year-by-year, for every major league club as far back as 1876, at least.
- 2 - Compile a list of Hall of Fame members and the scouts credited with their signing (if it hasn't already been done).
- 3 - Compile a list of every member of every major league all-star game and the scout credited with their signing.
- 4 - By major league organization, attempt to compile a list, by scout thru the years, of every player signed by each staff. This one might finish about 2050, but it should not be too difficult to do since the draft came into being in 1965.

A MAJOR, MAJOR PROJECT

I have had contact with the chairmen of the Biographical and Oral History Committees and we all are working together to get to some of the older scouts who are still available for interviews. Below is a list of scouts we must consider for inclusion in the Hall of Fame Museum exhibit.

It is from the files of many of these people that we will eventually draw the data which will grace the exhibit in the Hall's Museum.

If you know any of the following who are still alive and kicking - or if you are friends of the families of those who are gone and feel comfortable in going thru their archives - please let me know so we can begin to move.

MORE PLANS

The ultimate project would be to put a signing scout with every player in the composite Baseball Encyclopedia. Any takers yet?

DATA

As you meet scouts and families of former scouts and have access to various reports, records, files, etc., which would be of great interest

to anyone visiting the scouts' exhibit in the Hall of Fame Museum, see if the data can be brought to Cooperstown either on a loan or as permanent files. The Museum is interested in old contracts, old reports, notes scouts might have made at a ball game upon seeing a future Hall of Famer in action for the first time, pictures of the old-timers, etc..

A PROBLEM

A look at the list of signing scouts will come up with lots of duplication. For instance, Honus Wagner is credited to three people - Ed Barrow, George Moreland, and Barney Dreyfuss. Take your pick.

Wayne McElreavy brings out many associated problems when setting up his lists. What do you do when you get three different players signed at different times by Bob Smith, Robert Smith, and Robert L. Smith - all from the Midwest. Are they the same person? And what if Bob Miller was signed by one of the above Smiths? Or Bobby Jones? There were two Millers in the majors at the same time and there are two Joneses there today. Give us a decade and we'll get it all worked out? Right? At least we'll try.

Seriously, we'll look at the above problems with the idea that, as a scout, we know that often three people are involved with the signing of a player. Woody Fryman came to a tryout in Kentucky back about 1963. He simply walked in. There were four full-time scouts running the tryout. Woody came because his family's tobacco allotment had been cut the day before and the family's income was halved. Woody had refused contracts for years because tobacco farming paid better than the minor leagues. Now he was ready to go. So who found Woody Fryman? Three of the four always claimed him. Probably some umpire first found Woody in a Legion game at age 16, but we'll never know. Credit? Either all four - or none, regardless of who gave Woody the pen and did the contract. Actually, the guy in the Dept. of Agriculture office who cut the Frymans' tobacco allotment was responsible for Woody's signing.

NEXT NEWSLETTER

Will try to get back to you in mid-December with a third bulletin as we struggle to get things going.
