AL wildcards: Rays (5 votes); A's (4 votes); Red Sox, Yankees, Indians, Twins, Mariners (2 votes each); Rangers (1 vote)

NL wildcards: Cardinals and Brewers (3 votes each); Cardinals, Mets, Cubs, Rockies, Nationals (2 votes each); Dodgers, Giants, Pirates, Phillies (1 vote each).
